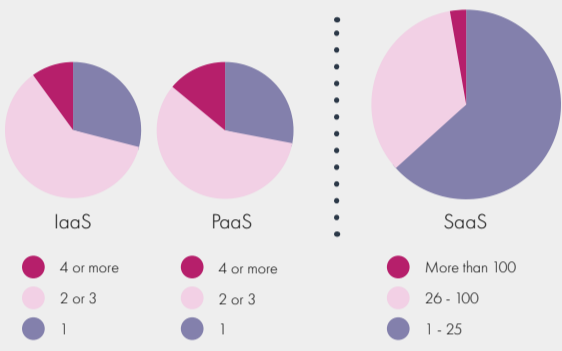

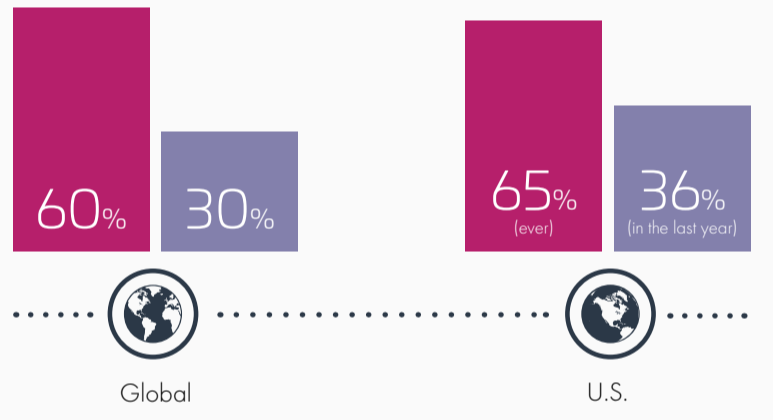
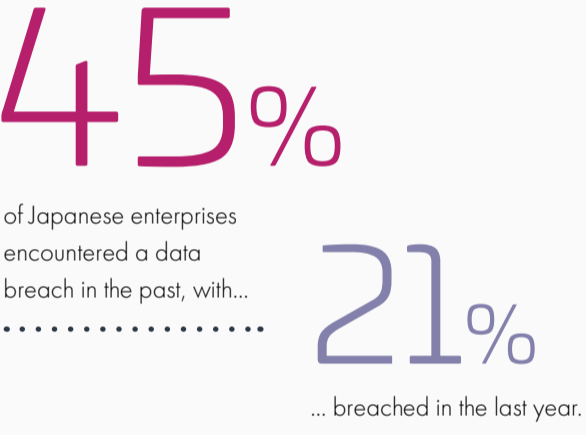
### The reality of the multi-cloud enterprise

Number of cloud environments

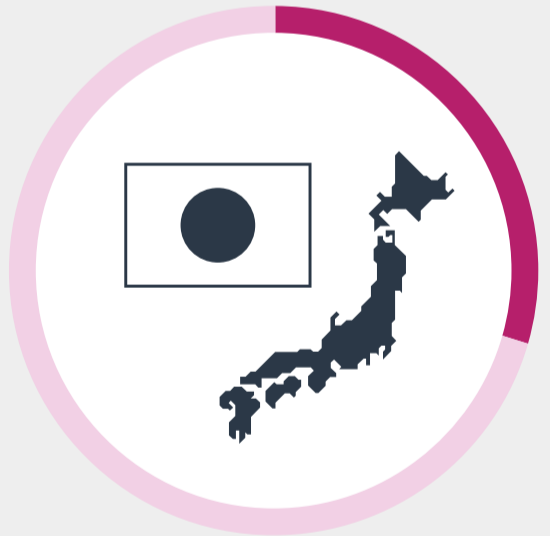
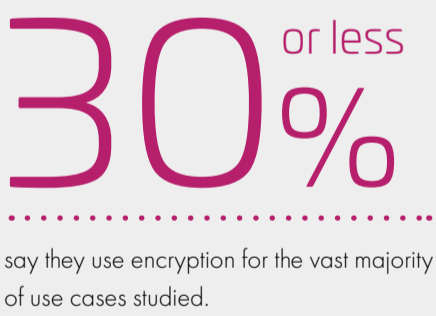


### Nearly half of Japanese enterprises encounter a data breach



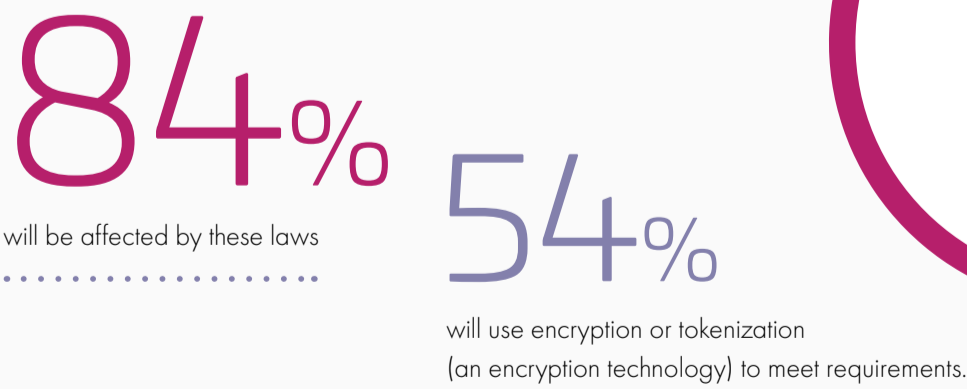
### Encryption rates are low
